



Second Week of Easter (Divine Mercy)

Readings: Acts 4:32-35; Psalm: 117; John 5:1-6; John 20:19-31



Liturgically the Easter Octave has always been centred on the theme of Divine Mercy and forgiveness. Divine Mercy Sunday, therefore, points us to the merciful love of God that lies behind the whole Paschal Mystery — the whole mystery of the death, burial and resurrection of Christ — made present for us in the Eucharist. In this way, it also sums up the whole Easter Octave. As Pope John Paul II pointed out in his Regina Caeli address on Divine Mercy Sunday,1995: "the whole octave of Easter is like a single day," and the Octave Sunday is meant to be the day of "thanksgiving for the goodness God has shown to humanity in the whole Easter mystery".

A Happy Feast Day to our Parish Divine Mercy Group. Many of them join us for the 8.30am mass this Sunday morning.

"We cannot build a society that advances women's rights based on lies and inconsistencies. During a miscarriage, an unborn child tragically dies. During an abortion, an unborn child is killed, but there is a major difference. The tragedy caused by abortion is preventable. Affirming the death of a child in miscarriage is a tragedy, while pretending that abortion is somehow a woman's right, leads down a very dark road where an unborn child's worth is based simply on whether he or she is wanted. Hopefully, New Zealand's Bereavement Leave for Miscarriage Bill will prompt the need for pro-life legislation which truly advances women's rights.
